## **Application and Conditions of entry**

Playors Dotails

The Australian Hellenic Golf Open is presented by the Australian Hellenic Golf Federation. The Tournament shall be under the management and control of a Match Committee, headed and appointed by the Tournament Director, whose decision on all matters to the tournament shall be final. The Tournament will be played over 36 holes of Individual Stroke Play comprising two 18-hole rounds conducted on Saturday (23/10/2010) and Sunday (24/10/2010). No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. A refund of fees will not be considered for cancellation of confirmed bookings or in the event of cancellation of any, or all, of the rounds due to inclement weather.

The Tournament is open to all golfers who hold a current AGU Handicap. Social club handicaps will only be accepted from players who are members of the constituent golf clubs of the AHGF and where that player has no AGU Handicap. Otherwise only players with an official AGU handicap will be eligible to win any tournament prizes. Evidence of current handicap must accompany the entry form and must also be provided at registration on the day of the tournament. Social handicaps will also have to be accompanied by signed documentation from the respective constituent Club. The Match Committee reserves the right to request further information as required to confirm a player's handicap. The maximum handicap will be 27.

Play shall be in accordance with the rules of golf and the local rules of the Host Club. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Match Committee. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. In the event of a tie, the AHGO champion will be decided by a sudden-death Playoff commencing on the 1st hole, and continuing on subsequent holes in course order until a winner is determined, and the Grade Winner by a count back. All competitors participate in the Tournament at their own risk. The AHGF, Match Committee, the sponsors, the host club and other supporters of the Tournament accept no liability for any death, injury, property loss or damage incurred by competitors, non-players, companions, spouses, spectators or other invitees during or arising out of any aspect of the conduct of the presentation of the Tournament.

Members of the Australian Hellenic Golf Federation will be given priority entry to the Tournament should registrations exceed available tournament places.

The AHGF Committee reserves the right to vary, amend and add to these conditions in its absolute discretion.
